Report on Library Funding 2009/2010

At last Pennsylvania has a state budget for 2009/2010! Public library funding has been substantially reduced. The **direct** impact to Snyder County Libraries will be \$30,000 less in state funding than in the previous year, a result of cuts to the Public Library Subsidy. There will be **indirect** effects as well resulting from dramatically reduced funding for other library line items that involve services such as POWER Library, Interlibrary Loan, etc. The library is examining various ways to deal with these impacts, including reducing expenses where possible and appropriate, and increasing income through more fund raising events. We hope that our Friends members will support the library in this difficult time.
