Library Funding 2010-11

Governor Rendell's 2010-11 proposed budget contains more cuts in library funding – bad news when libraries continue to be busier than ever! The proposed cuts total 1.9% in four categories (Commonwealth Libraries, Library Services for the Visually Impaired & Disabled, Library Access, including POWER Library and the Public Library Subsidy). For the 2010-11 state budget, the Pennsylvania Library Association is urging Governor Rendell, State Senators and State Representatives to support:

1. A \$3 million increase to restore Library Access, especially the POWER Library electronic resources - used 76 million times last year (this program was cut 73%).
2. A 5% increase in the Public Library Subsidy.



The net profit of \$2,200 from Tree Fest has been donated to the library and will help fund Snyder County Libraries 2010 Summer Reading Program, which is available to all children in Snyder County.

The library's December pre-school story hours were held at Tree Fest with community members reading to the kids. This is always a hit with the children and their family members.

Many people work together to make Tree Fest such a wonderful community event. Selinsgrove Area Rotary Club gave us hours of volunteer help during setup and Kohls Department Store's A-Team provided 15 hours of volunteer help during clean-up, and a \$500 grant through their community program which supports childhood literacy. We're deeply grateful to each and every person who volunteers time to help out – thank you all!

We are starting to plan Tree Fest 2010 and Decorator Brochures will be in the mail shortly. Unfortunately, due to the press of other business, we haven't been able to put up a Tree Fest Virtual Tour 2009 on our website as yet. We will get that posted as soon as possible.

Annual Donation to Library

To comply with state accounting rules for libraries receiving state funding, Friends now follows a policy of accumulating profits from fund-raising efforts throughout the calendar year and issuing a check to the library in January of the following year to fund the library's Wish List for that year. In the past we issued the check at the end of the calendar year.

This year, instead of the customary prioritized Wish List of specific items, the library communicated to Friends that they will be forced to make cut backs in 2010 due to budget cuts at the state level. They therefore requested that they be able to use Friends donation in an unrestricted manner. They plan to use the funds on children's programs and library collections. They pledged to make sure that they use Friends donated monies to pay for items that we will be proud to communicate to you.

Early in 2010, Friends issued a donation check to the library in the amount of \$12,000 from funds raised in calendar year 2009. We're proud to announce that our donations since inception in 2003 now total \$79,000.

2010 Institute for Trustees and Friends

On March 20, 2010, Del Kennedy (President, Snyder County Library Board), Pamela Ross (Executive Director Snyder County Libraries), and Elizabeth Heim (Friends of the Selinsgrove Community Library) attended the one-day 2010 Institute entitled "Library Survival Tactics – Let's Not Waste a Good Crisis". The Institute focused on ways in which the three entities (Trustees, Directors and Friends) can work together, within their specific roles, to make our libraries the best that they can be during this crisis and in the future.
